## Chili Cook-Off Rules & Prizes:

1. \$25.00 entry fee per chili (You can enter as many recipes as you like).
2. Participants must provide ALL of your own supplies: food, tables, utensils for cooking and propane if needed. Electricity is available upon request. (See above). We recommend you provide your own shade.
3. All cooking must be done on premises. Beans maybe pre-soaked, other items may be pre-chopped. Canned goods may be used but not opened before the official 10:00 A.M. start time.
4. 10'x10' booth is provided. Tables/Booth set-up (decoration) may begin at 9:00 A.M. Please limit the size of your booth/table/shade canopy to 10x10. Set-up in pre-designated spots only.
5. Nothing maybe cooked or started prior to the 10:00 A.M. start time. Chili must be ready for tasting by 2:00 P.M.
6. ANYTHING GOES! (Note: International Chili Cook-Off rules DO NOT apply).
7. Plan to make at least (4) quarts of chili (250 samples).
8. There will be five awards/prizes: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners, a "People's Choice Award" and a "Best Decorated Chili Booth" award. Raffle prizes awarded also.
9. All decisions of the judges are final.
10. Deadline for the entry form is one (1) week prior to Silverado Days opening day, or \$50.00 fee for late entries up to the opening day provided there is space available.
