1 -\$25.00 entry fee per chili (You can enter as many recipes as you like)

- Participates must provide ALL of your own supplies: food, tables, utensils for cooking and propane if needed.
  Electricity is available upon request. (See above) We recommend you provide your own shade.
- 3 Beans may be pre-soaked, other Items may be pre-chopped Canned goods may be used but not opened before the official 6:00 A.M start time
- 4 10' x 10' booth is provided. Tables/Booth set-up (decoration) may begin at 6:00 A.M. Please limit the size of your booth/table/shade canopy to 10 x 10 Set-up in pre-designated spots only.
- 5 Only meat may be pre-cooked prior to the 6:00 A.M. start time. Chili must be ready for tasting by Noon.
- 6 ANYTHING GOES' (Note' International Chili Cook-Off rules DO NOT apply).
- Plan to make at least (5i quarts of chili (350 samples)
- There will be cash awards/prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> =\$150.00, -2nd= \$100.00, & 3rd= \$50.00 plus plaques for "Best Decorated Chili Booth" and "Best Chili Team."
- 9 "People's Choice Award" will have a special prize of \$200.00 to the winning "People's Choice" recipe.
- 10. All decisions of the judges are final.
- Deadline for the entry form is one (1) week prior to Silverado Days opening day, or \$50.00 fee for late entries up to the opening day provided there is space available
